Motorcycle Safety

While this section could include all of the same old information that we all hear over and over, we decided to just tell everyone to take notice of the numbers of fatalities that are listed on the TDOT signs. They change DAILY.

Remember, that while the majority of that number is automobiles, motorcycles are included in that number. This means that as a dual vehicle operator,

your chances are increased. Additionally, as a motorcycle rider, your chances of having an accident may be less than an automobile, but the chances of the outcome being death are greatly increased when you are riding.

Be smart about your riding and watch out for your fellow riders. If they've had too much to drink, do NOT allow them to get on their bike. Be a good

example to others and don't ride your bike if you've had too much.

Be mindful of the road and those on it. We've already lost too many of our friends and do NOT want to lose any more.
